Post-operative care after brain tumor or pituitary tumor surgery: (What to expect and follow-up appointments)

- **After craniotomy:**
 - Most patients will spend at least one night in the intensive care unit (ICU) and then typically 2 or 3 additional nights on a regular (non-ICU) ward.
 - You will likely have some incisional pain and mild to moderate headache for which you will be given pain medication.
 - You may have a CT scan or MRI before your discharge home.
 - Your first follow-up appointment with Dr. Kelly/Dr. Kassam will be 2 - 3 weeks after surgery.
 - Your 2nd follow-up appointment with Dr. Kelly/Dr. Kassam will be 2 - 3 months after surgery.
 - Additional follow-up appointments with other specialists will be arranged as needed.

- **After endonasal transsphenoidal surgery:**
 - Most patients will spend two nights on a regular (non-ICU) ward.
 - You will typically have some incisional pain if you had an abdominal fat graft taken and mild to moderate headache for which you will be given pain medication; nasal congestion and some bloody nasal drainage is also common.
 - You may have a CT scan or MRI before your discharge home.
 - Your first follow-up appointment with Dr. Kelly/ Dr. Kassam will be 2 - 3 weeks after surgery.
 - Your second follow-up appointment with Dr. Kelly/ Dr. Kassam will typically be 2 - 3 months after surgery.
 - Additional follow-up appointments with other specialists will be arranged as needed.
